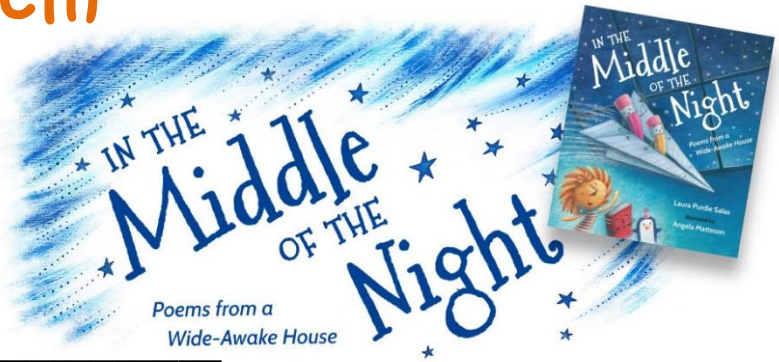


# Write a Night Poem
